Dear Parents,

Our 2007 / 2008 dance season is going by quickly. It's hard to believe that our "Piano Man" production is just around the corner. It's going to be a great show!

The office staff have been very busy getting ready for next year. Scheduling of classes and placements of students has now been completed.

So many components are involved in preparing a dance schedule. Example:

- ◇ Where possible, for convenience sake we have tried our best to group certain classes on the same evening so that your child can attend two different dance forms on one day.
- ◇ Extra care and thought has been taken into the placement of your child. Please understand that in certain situations students may not always end up in the same classes with their friends. We realize this may be a sensitive issue however, when doing class placement we take the following into consideration: technical levels, exposure to different dance forms, experience, age, maturity and of course class sizes. Preparing classes that are well balanced will benefit all students.
- ◇ Please keep in mind that for the first month of classes, all students are assessed to ensure that we have placed them in the appropriate technical level. Appropriate levels will not only enhance the students' ability but will ensure that her/his needs are being met. Some students may need to be moved which will result in a class and time change. We will be continuing to monitor this situation throughout the year. Thank you for your understanding.
- ◇ **All classes are subject to change or cancellation pending registration.** Enclosed you will find next years dance schedule and highlighted classes for your child.
- ◇ Highlighted in pink are the classes your child has been placed in for next year assuming that she/he will continue with the same repertoire of classes taken this past year.
- ◇ Highlighted in yellow are "suggestion classes only". Often children pursue different dance forms from year to year. Also, teachers see potential in students and encourage them to expand their dance repertoire. These "suggestion classes only" will hopefully assist you during registration should your child want to try different classes.
- ◇ Students participating in our "**Jazz competition**" classes next year **must** take an additional dance form. This can be ballet, modern or lyrical jazz. These competition classes are for the more serious students who attend more than two classes per week.

If you have any concerns or questions regarding your child's placement please take a brief moment to chat with your child's teacher prior to registration. This will help to expedite registration. Thank you.

Final details:

- ◇ It is **very important** that you bring your highlighted schedule with you to registration.
- ◇ You will need to submit your registration and costume deposit cheques dated for the day you register.
- ◇ Your first and last months cheques, September and May, need to be dated for Sept. 1/08.
- ◇ Your postdated cheques for the remainder of the year should be dated for each month following. (Oct. through to April)
- ◇ To hold a placement for your child, all postdated cheques must be submitted for the entire year at the time of registration.
- ◇ By completing your registration and submitting your cheques you will no longer have to visit the office in September.
- ◇ Siblings will continue to enjoy our family discount.
- ◇ Following registration, classes will be open to new students from outside the school.
- ◇ Please note that some classes will fill quickly. Register early to avoid disappointment!
- ◇ Please note: Your 2007/2008 account must be paid in full prior to registering for the new year.
